

## European Picture Pedestal Plaque Instructions

### Included Materials:

| 2. (1) Back Plate             | 6. (1) #10 x 2 ½" Screw   |
| 3. (1) Pedestal               | 7. (1) Picture Cover      |
| 4. (2) #8 x 1 ¼ Machine Screw | 8. (4) Brass Tack         |



### 1. Drill Hole in Skull

Using a 1/8" drill bit, drill a hole in the bottom of your skull (see Fig. 1).

### 2. Attach Pedestal to Face Plate

Using a #8 x 1 ¼" screw, slide the screw through the center hole in the face plate and screw it into the insert in the center of angled side of pedestal. Before tightening all the way make sure the pedestal is square with face plate. Now use a #6 x 1" set screw in the second hole in the face plate.

### 3. Mount Skull to Face Plate

Using the #10 x 2 ½" screw, slide the screw through the hole in the face plate and screw into the hole from step 1. Before tightening the screw all the way, make sure the skull is straight on the plaque.

### 4. Attach Back Plate to Pedestal

First, layout the picture and skull on the back plate and mark where the pedestal will attach to the back plate. Now drill (2) 3/16" holes ¾" apart. One hole will be for machine screw and one for the skull set screw. Using #8 x 1 ¼" screw, slide the screw through the hole in the back plate and screw it into the insert in the bottom of pedestal. Before tightening all the way make sure the pedestal is square on the back plate. Now use a #6 x 1 set screw in the second hole.

### 5. Attach Picture Cover
